Construction Observation:

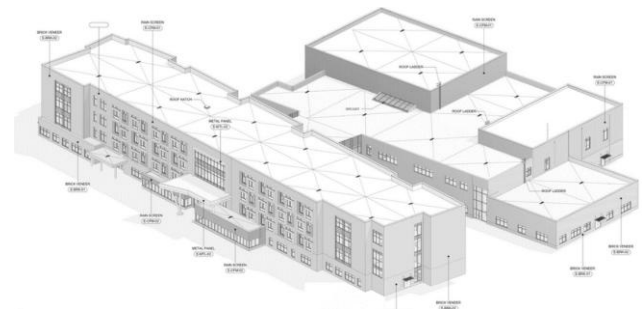
- Site Electrical Underground Piping

- Temporary road closures – NOTE: Flaggers will be onsite to safely guide motorists through the construction zone.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS) is embarking on an ambitious project to design, construct, finance, and maintain 8 new schools. This initiative, known as the Phase 2 Project, is part of the Blueprint Schools Program aimed at providing modern, sustainable educational facilities. The project is being developed by Progressive Education Partners (PEP) and involves a public-private partnership (P3) model.



The new school will span approximately 230,778 square feet, providing a modern and spacious environment for students and staff. The construction is expected to be completed by July 2027, ensuring that the new school is ready for occupancy for the 2027-2028 academic year. Throughout the duration of the project, we will provide numerous opportunities for community engagement and participation.
