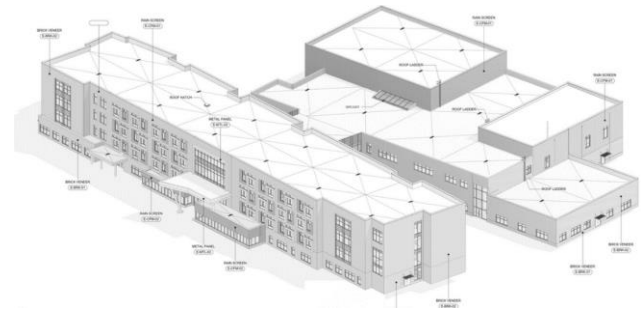




PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Prince George’s County Public Schools (PGCPS) is embarking on an ambitious project to design, construct, finance, and maintain 8 new schools. This initiative, known as the Phase 2 Project, is part of the Blueprint Schools Program aimed at providing modern, sustainable educational facilities. The project is being developed by Progressive Education Partners (PEP) and involves a public-private partnership (P3) model.



The new school will span approximately 230,778 square feet, providing a modern and spacious environment for students and staff. The construction is expected to be completed by July 2027, ensuring that the new school is ready for occupancy for the 2027-2028 academic year. Throughout the duration of the project, we will provide numerous opportunities for community engagement and participation. CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

Robert Frost Elementary School is undergoing a significant transformation. The existing Robert Frost Elementary School will be demolished to make way for a new, state-of-the-art Robert Frost K-8 School. The demolition and construction are scheduled to begin with the site becoming available on September 16, 2024. There will be an increase in site activity, and we have taken measures to control sound pollution. Noise levels to be monitored as well.

Construction Observation:

- Installation of construction fencing around the project work site
- Demolition and removal of existing buildings
- Enhanced site security
- Temporary road closures – NOTE: Flaggers will be onsite to safely guide motorists through the construction zone.
